Now that most of the concrete slab has been poured, walls are going up for the new Academic Center. Studs started going up on November 3rd, and now sheeting has been going up. Block walls were also constructed for what will be the music room, a room that will also be utilized as a storm shelter. At the same time, wells are being drilled which will be used for the geothermal HVAC system. Some ILC students also volunteered their time to bury conduit for the building's fiber optic network.
